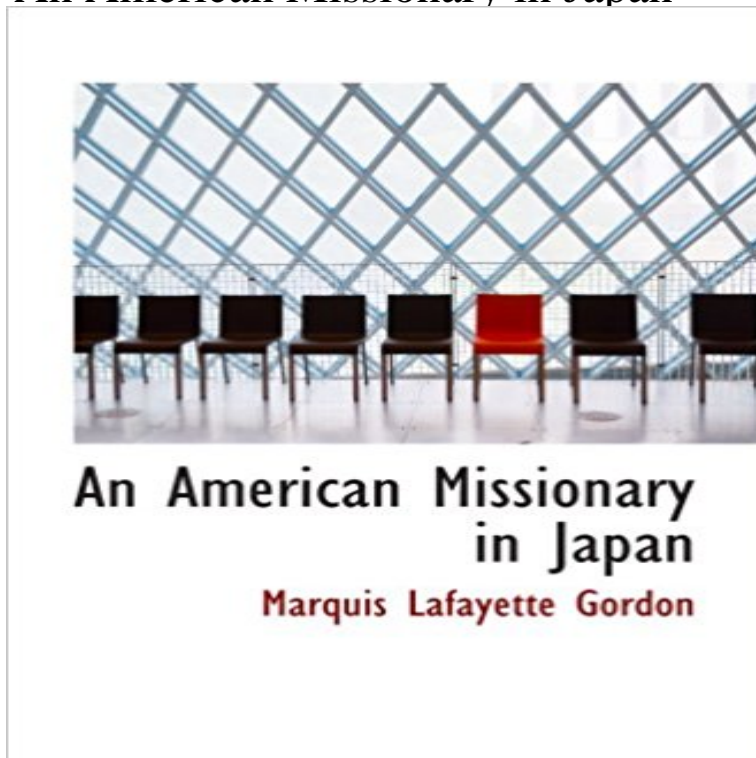


## An American Missionary in Japan
