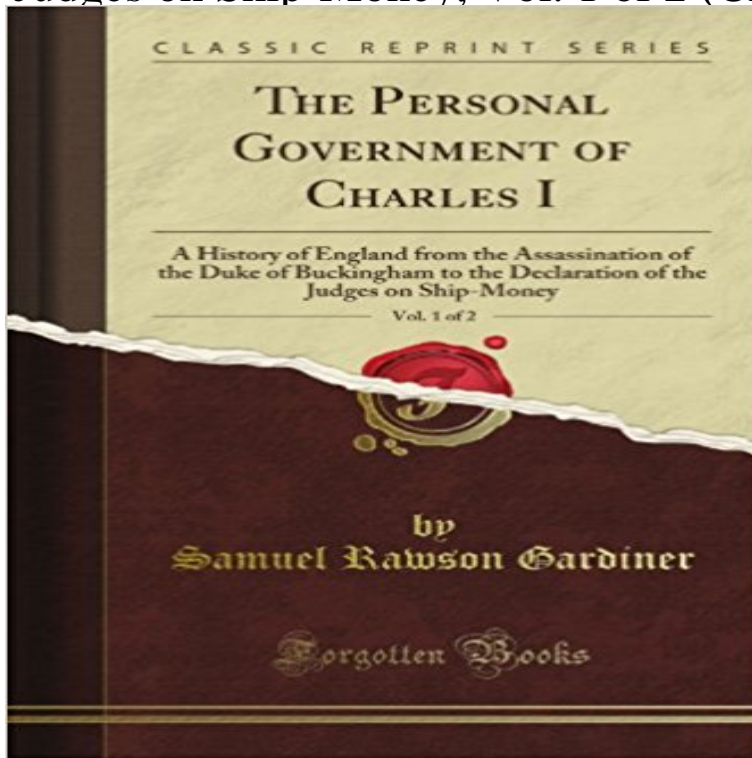

The two volumes now published will bring the reader to the threshold of the Puritan Evolution, as the demonstration in the streets of London at the execution of the sentence upon Prynne, Burton, and Bastwick, together with the almost simultaneous demonstration at Edinburgh upon the introduction of the new Prayer Book, may fairly be regarded as the starting points of the movement. The period of nine years here treated of is one in which many causes were at work to undermine the Eoyal authority, and an accurate knowledge of these less exciting times is therefore absolutely indispensable to the formation of a sober judgment on the more stirring events which followed.
