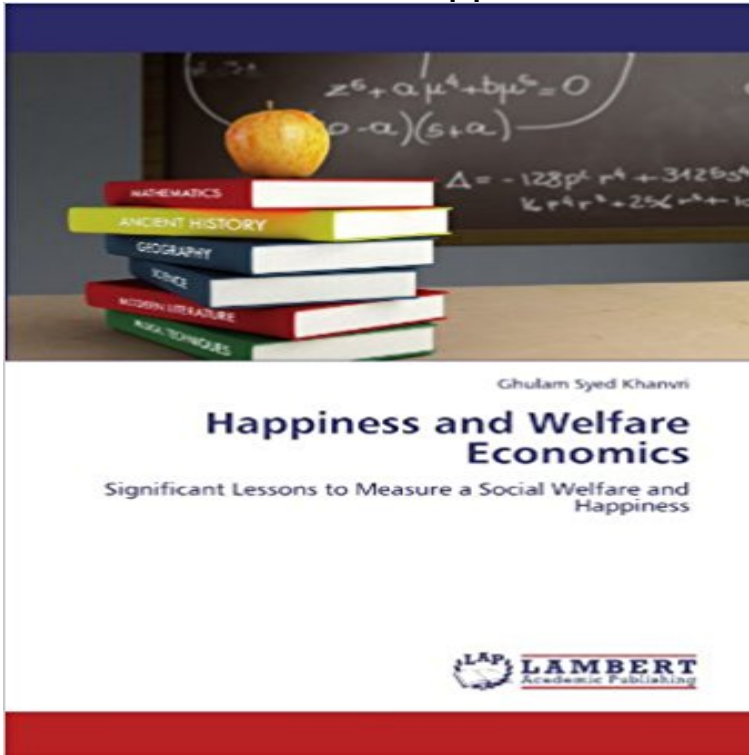


Happiness and Welfare Economics: Significant Lessons to Measure a Social Welfare and Happiness
