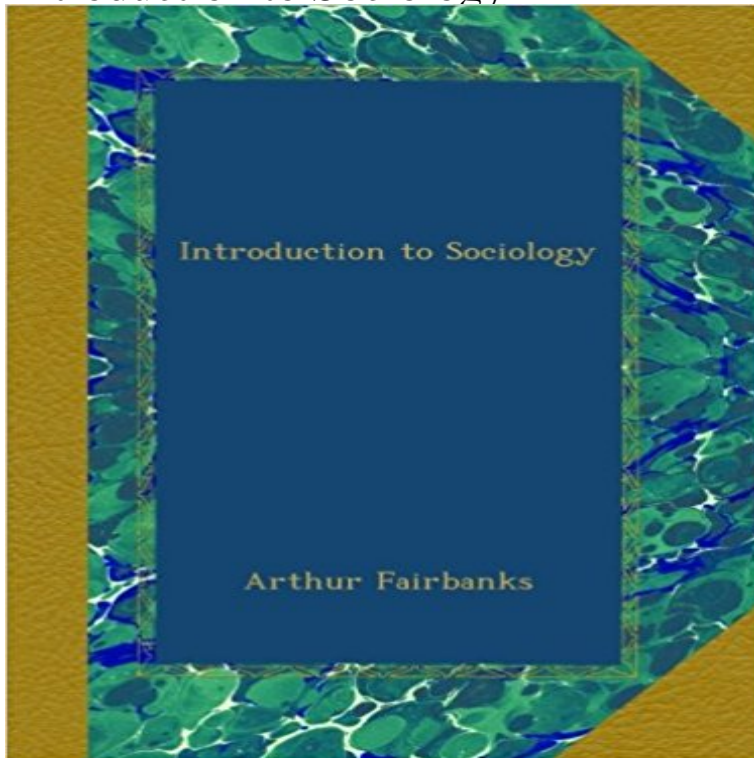


# Introduction to Sociology
