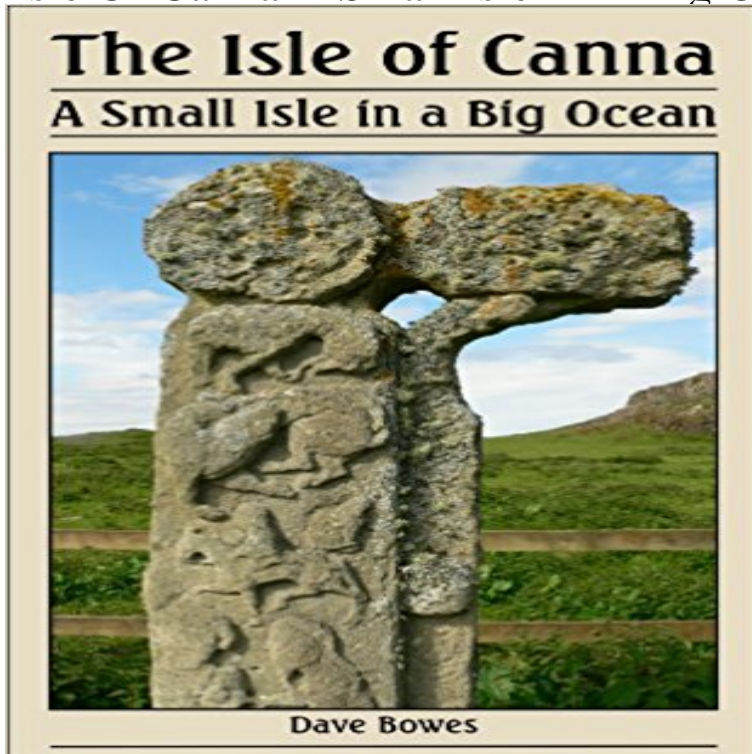


Isle Of Canna A Small Isle In A Big Ocean
