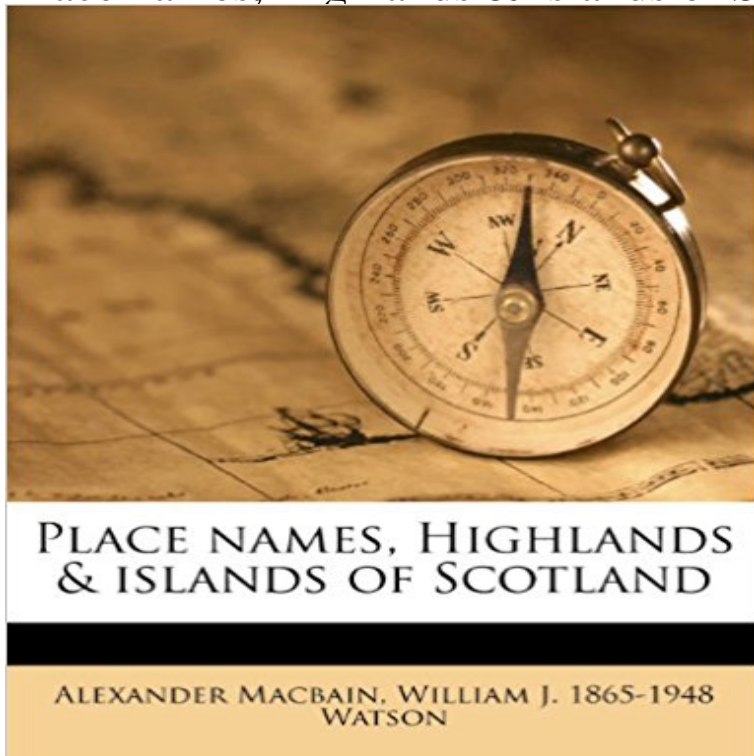


Place names, Highlands & islands of Scotland
