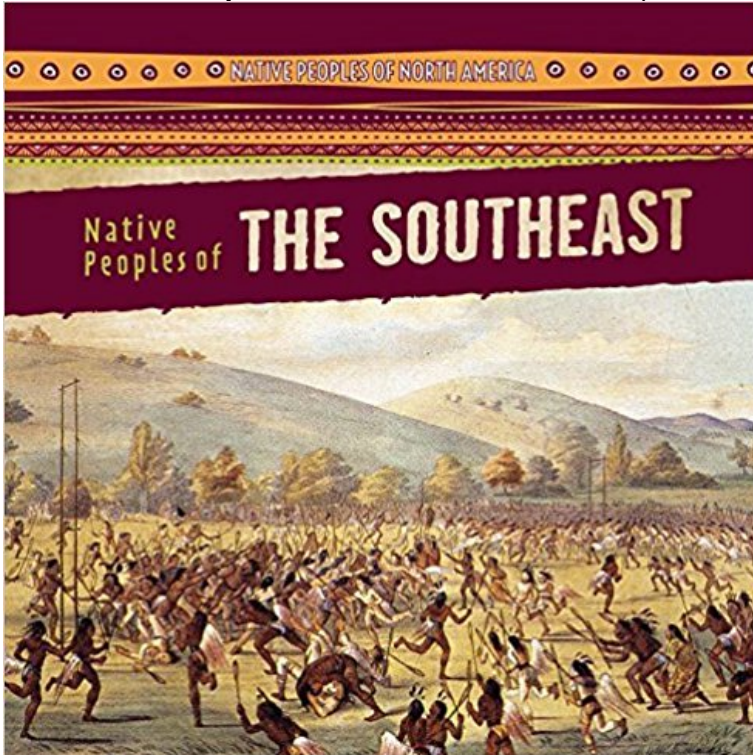


Native Peoples of the Southeast (Native Peoples of North America)
