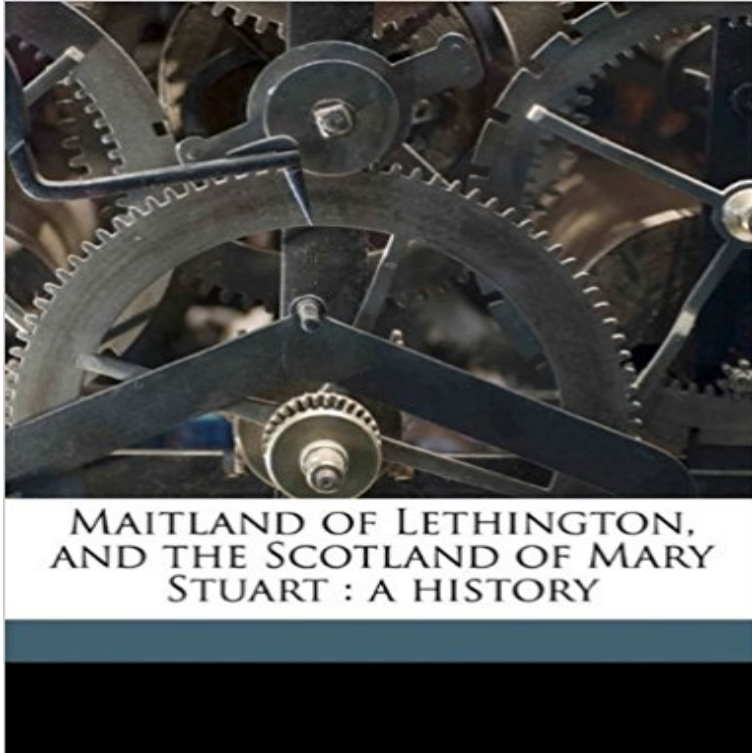


Maitland of Lethington, and the Scotland of Mary Stuart: a history Volume 1
