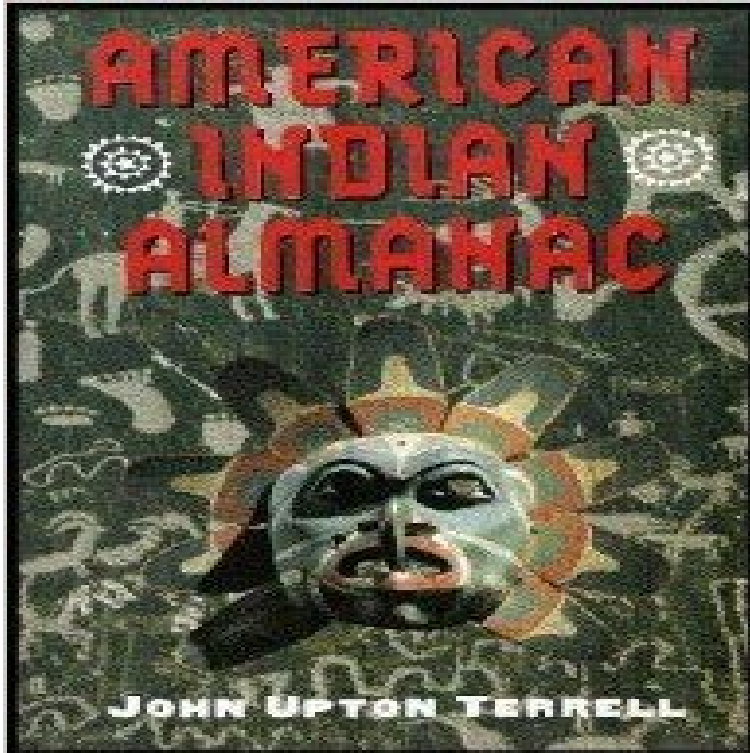


American Indian Almanac (Answers Questions About the First Human Beings to Occupy the United States)
