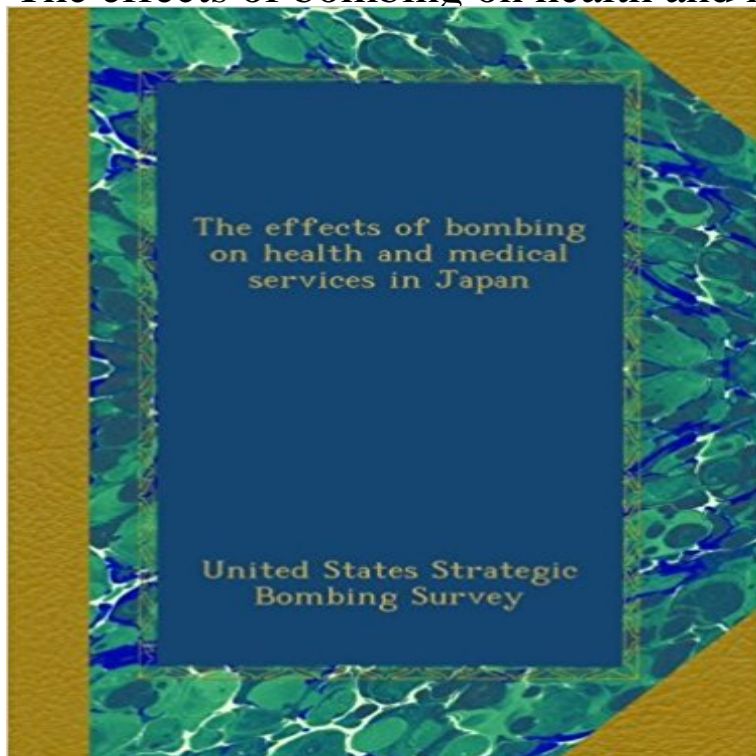


## The effects of bombing on health and medical services in Japan
