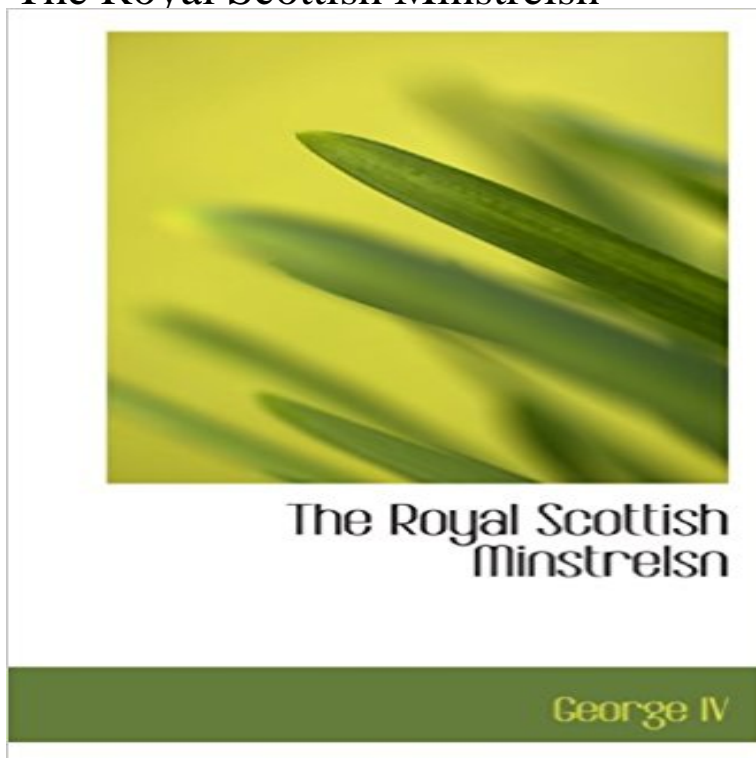


## The Royal Scottish Minstrelsn
