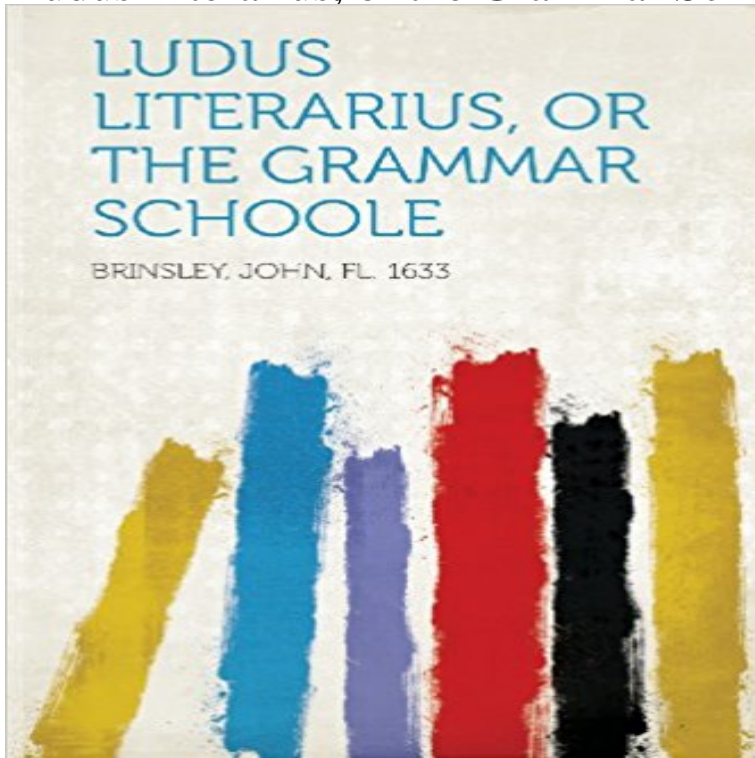


Ludus Literarius, or the Grammar Schoole (German Edition)
