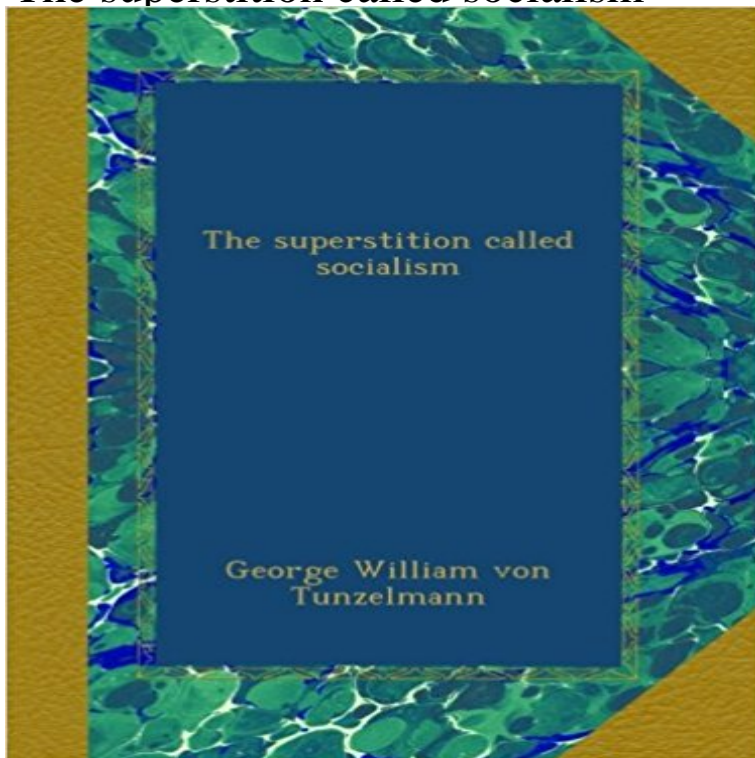


The superstition called socialism
